

FIRE-RESISTANT LANDSCAPING FOR YOUR HOME

Choosing the right fire-resistant plants and materials can beautify your suburban home and also help reduce your wildfire risk.





INSIDE THE HOME IGNITION ZONE (0-5 FEET FROM YOUR HOME)

Best Practice

For the best protection, keep this area clear of all combustible materials. Use noncombustible hardscapes, such as concrete pavers, flagstone paths, decorative gravel (rock mulch), and natural stones. The best option is to keep the area clear of plants, especially if you have combustible siding such as wood or vinyl.



The best practice is to keep all combustible materials out of the Home Ignition Zone.

Next Best Option

If you have noncombustible siding such as fiber-cement and you choose to have plants in this zone, limit your selection to varieties that grown no more than 12 inches in height. Be sure to water and care for any vegetation in this zone as any plant can become highly flammable if it is dead, dried out, or not well maintained.

PAST THE HOME IGNITION ZONE (5+ FEET FROM YOUR HOME)

- Include at least 4 feet of space between plant/flower beds.
- For beds with different plant varieties, base spacing on the tallest plant's maximum height and
 make sure the next bed is at least twice this length away. Also consider the maximum width of
 each plant to avoid creating very dense vegetation and to ensure adequate spacing between
 beds.
- Consider using hardscape materials between beds.
- Avoid creating long, continuous beds which could act as a path for fire.
- Privacy screens/hedge rows of arborvitaes, cedars, or other evergreens are not recommended. At a minimum, these should not encroach into the Home Ignition Zone or your neighbor's wildfireresistant landscaping.

RECOMMENDED MATERIALS (WITHIN 30 FEET OF YOUR HOME)

- Avoid combustible materials such as pine straw and wood mulch.
- Use noncombustible hardscapes such as concrete pavers, decorative gravel (rock mulch), flagstone, and natural stones such as Mexican Beach pebbles.

Rosa woodsii USDA Hardiness Zone: 4-8 Spacing: 12'+ / Height: 3'-6' Spread: 3'-6'

Western Spirea

Spirea douglasii USDA Hardiness Zone: 4-8 Spacing: 12'+ / Height: 3'-6' Spread: 3'-6'

Tall Shrubs & Trees

- Trees should have their limbs trimmed so all branches, leaves, or needles are above 15 feet or your house's roof line, whichever is tallest.
- Consider using only 1 tall shrub or tree within 30 feet of your home. If you plant more than 1, make sure there is a minimum of 10 feet of space between them.
- Do NOT plant within the Home Ignition Zone or any area where the tree may eventually overhang your roof at its largest size. This could lead to a buildup of flammable debris on your roof. Additionally, the tree or shrub could serve as a large fuel source right next to your home. It could also fall on your home in a windstorm. Over time, root systems may also puncture your home's underground plumbing and even cause foundation problems.

Note: Given the relatively short height, consider spacing more than 10 feet and make sure limbs are trimmed 3'-4' above the ground.

European Beech

Fernleaf Buckthorn

Rhamnus frangula 'Aspenifolia' USDA Hardiness Zone: 2-7 Spacing: 24'+ / Height: 10'-12' Spread: 6'-10'

Flowering Dogwood

Cornus florida USDA Hardiness Zone: 5-9 Spacing: > 10' / Height: 20'-30' Spread: 15'-20'

Green Ash

Faxinus pennsylvanica USDA Hardiness Zone: 3-9 Spacing: > 10' / Height: 40'-60' Spread: 20'-40'

Hawthorn

Crataegus species USDA Hardiness Zone: 4-7 Spacing: > 10' / Height: 15'-20' Spread: 10'-15'

Note: Given its relatively short height, consider using 2 times the height as proper spacing, and keep branches pruned above the ground.

Horsechestnut

Kentucky Coffee Tree

Alnus tenuifolia USDA Hardiness Zone: 5-8 Spacing: > 10' / Height: 20'-25' Spread: 15'-20'

Mountain Ash

Sorbus aucuparia USDA Hardiness Zone: 3-7 Spacing: > 10' / Height: 20'-30' Spread: 15'-20'

Pin Oak

Quercus palustris USDA Hardiness Zone: 4-8 Spacing: > 10' / Height: 50'-70' Spread: 25'-40'

Purple Robe Locust

Robinia pseudocacia 'purple robe'

USDA Hardiness Zone: 3-8 Spacing: > 10' / Height: 30'-40' Spread: 20'-30'

Quaking Aspen

Populus tremuloides USDA Hardiness Zone: 1-8 Spacing: > 10' / Height: 30'-40' Spread: 12'-15'

Note: This tree will produce suckers to produce a grove of trees. Consider using outside of the 30-foot zone in a larger landscape setting.

Red Alder

Alnus rubra USDA Hardiness Zone: 5-8 Spacing: > 10' / Height: 45'-50' Spread: 20'-30'

Red Oak

Quercus rubra USDA Hardiness Zone: 4-8 Spacing: > 10' / Height: 60'-75' Spread: 40'-50'

Rocky Mountain Maple

Acer glabrum USDA Hardiness Zone: 3-7 Spacing: > 10' / Height: 10'-15' Spread: 10'-15'

Sumac

Rhus species USDA Hardiness Zone: 3-9 Spacing: > 30' / Height: 2'-20'

Spread: 4'-15'

Tallhedge

Rhamnus frangula 'Columnaris' USDA Hardiness Zone: 2-7 Spacing: 24'+ / Height: 8'-12' Spread: 3'-4'

Thornless Honeylocust

Gleditsia triacanthos var. inermis. cvs USDA Hardiness Zone: 3-9 Spacing: > 10' / Height: 35'-40' Spread: 30'-50'

Vine Maple

Acer circinatum USDA Hardiness Zone: 4-8 Spacing: > 10' / Height: 15'-20' Spread: 15'-20'

Walnut

Juglans species USDA Hardiness Zone: 4-9 Spacing: > 10' / Height: 40'-60'+ Spread: 30'-50'

Western Catalpa

Catalpa speciosa USDA Hardiness Zone: 4-8 Spacing: > 10' / Height: 40'-50' Spread: 20'-25'

Western Larch

Lariz occidentalis USDA Hardiness Zone: 4-7 Spacing: > 10' / Height: 100'-180' Spread: 30'-40'

Note: Keep branches trimmed to a height of at least 15 feet.

Western Sycamore / California Sycamore

Platanus racemosa USDA Hardiness Zone: 7-9 Spacing: > 10' / Height: 40'-80' Spread: 50'-70'

White Ash

Faxinus americana USDA Hardiness Zone: 3-9 Spacing: > 10' / Height: 40'-60' Spread: 20'-40'

White Oak

Quercus garryana USDA Hardiness Zone: 6-9 Spacing: > 10' / Height: 40'-90' Spread: 30'-60'
